

Doctor's visits or surgery can cause stress for children of all ages. Knowing what to expect can lessen anxiety for both you and your child. That is why we are proud to offer The Pre-Operative Program (POP) which takes place every Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday at 2pm. Visits last approximately 30 to 45 minutes depending on your child's age and developmental level, and include the following information:

- **Pictures**: Seeing pictures of the actual rooms and given explanations of equipment can alleviate some anxiety. Patients will see pictures of the pre-surgery room, surgery room, and recovery room prior to surgery.
- **Medical Play**: This "hands on" experience will allow children to see and feel real medical tools in a playful way. Playing provides a non-threatening opportunity for children to prepare for what they may experience on the day of surgery.
- **Tour**: Allows children and families to meet medical staff and ask questions, and see places where they may stay.
